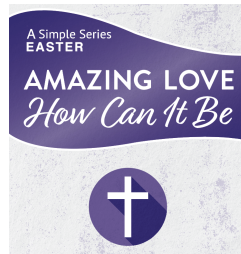

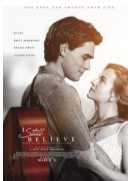
Yadkin Early College Prom Dinner
