**MEET STELLA**  
What began as an overnight hospital stay for newborn Stella turned into 22 days of complications. Born with Down syndrome, Josh and Gina Grant's little girl wasn't thriving. Exploratory stomach surgery was a last resort...but it worked. What wasn't working was figuring out how to pay all the medical bills. The family was talking bankruptcy when their bills were paid by the Mother's Day Offering. They helped save Stella's life," says Gina. That was 2014, but the Grant family's gratitude is still fresh all these years later...even though Josh was sick with COVID in January and slowly recovering. "With Stella and her follow-up surgery, even when I had COVID, we know it's in the Lord's hands," he says. "Every trial we had has always brought us closer to Him. Today, people are losing jobs, insurance, people they love. They need help, and now's the time to help them."
